**Short report from the meeting with partners of IP2329 CEPEMIS proposal  
Rome 6-7 September 2003**

The meeting was organised by Mr Ferran Cabrer I Vilagut from MUFICATA Company in Barcelona, Spain, who is chairman of EEIG CONSEN. This Group decided to submit a proposal of Integrated Project in FP6 second call in the IST Priority under the topic 3.2.9 "Improving Risk Management". The title of the proposal is: "Civil and Environmental Protection European Multi-risk Info-Space" – CEPEMIS. The first draft of the proposal was prepared by Muficata and sent to 17 partners before the meeting.

In the agenda not only the proposal CEPEMIS was to be discussed, but also PW had to present the proposal of a NoE SIMPPLE, which is a spin-off of the experience gained, when performing the SEWING project. According to the previous discussion, both proposals: CEPEMIS and SIMPPLE should have strict co-operation.

Eleven persons participated in the meeting, representing software and hardware engineering and consulting companies. The main goal of CEPEMIS is to create a network of info-space open platform for informing and risk prevention, which could be expanded for e-learning, e-government and other e-activities. As the result a pilot implementation is to be done. It will use the existing civil-protection network, improving it for broad and flexible use.

The discussion criticised strongly the first draft of the proposal. It was too long, the construction was not logical; the WPs didn't formulate the proper sequence of activities. The discussion that followed this criticism was rather tough and it looked that no positive conclusions could be found.

Finally one of the partners proposed a new set of WPs with more detailed tasks in each of them. It is hoped that Muficata will prepare the final version before the dead-line of October 15.

Two partners of SEWING participate in this proposal through CONSEN: PW and UPC.

The SEWING experience was presented during the meeting and a short presentation of SIMPPLE proposal was given. Some CONSEN partners want to participate in SIMPPLE, which is a spin-off proposal of SEWING. The slides of the presentation are attached to this report.
